Mini jumping 9:30am

Clear round jumping starting at 9:30

Starting at 20cm and going up to 40cm (this ring is designed to encourage novices).

Enter @ ringside (£4). Classes will run concurrently.

- Fun Mini Jumping- classes to be run throughout the day (ask at gate).
- Mini Minute Jumping (£4) Jump as many fences as you can in one minute. If you knock a fence down you cannot count that fence.
- Pairs (£8) Go with a friend. One fence to be jumped together and marked. Scored on combination of time. Jumping faults and dressing fence.
- Horse and hound (£4)- jump the course on the pint and then on foot with your dog. Fastest round with least fault wins.
