

Terms and Conditions

1. The horse trials will be run under British Eventing & SEG Competition rules unless stated in this schedule.
2. It is compulsory that all riders wear hats/helmets up to British Standard Riding Hats conforming to All PAS 015, VG1 – provided they are BSI Kitemarked, European – VG1 – provided they are BSI Kitemarked American – All SEI ASTM F1163 04a onwards and SNELL E2001 Australian & New Zealand – AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards.
All Hats must carry a Horse-Events Tag or 2018 British Eventing/PC or RC tag.
3. Riding is a risk sport and it is compulsory that all riders wear body protectors to the latest Beta Standard - we no longer permit the use of BETA Level 3 body protectors with a 2000 label. Air Jackets may be worn but must be worn over a body protector
4. It is compulsory that every person entering upon the Horse-Events venue who is under the age of 18 years of age is accompanied by a responsible adult.
5. Event stopwatches are allowed.
6. It is compulsory that all dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
7. It is compulsory that horseboxes are not to be mucked out on site.
8. The Management of the venue & Horse-Events reserves the right to remove anyone from the course at any time without giving a reason.
9. You note and accept there will be a paramedic, technician, doctor and 4x4 ambulance vehicle on site.
10. A vet will be present at the event and a farrier will either be present or on call.
11. The Event may be cancelled without notice due to adverse weather. In the event of adverse weather it is recommended that you check the website www.horse-events.co.uk
12. All horses/ponies must be 4 years and over.
13. If the event is cancelled, entry fees will be returned on to the payment card, minus a £10 admin fee per horse and rider combination.
14. You accept our withdrawal policy stated on the printed schedule and online.
15. Any queries or complaints must be in writing and handed to the Organiser within 30 minutes of the incident together with a fee of £50, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
16. Fall of competitor in any phase of the event will result in elimination. All falls must be checked by the doctor before leaving the venue.
17. Outside assistance is forbidden and will result in Elimination.
18. People must expect to have their photograph taken at many of our events and we reserve the right to publish suitable photographs of those attending, along with the names of members involved. If you do not wish for your photo to be published please inform the secretary at the individual event with your competitor number and your photo will not be taken. If you would like an existing published photo to be removed from our Media please email info@horse-events.co.uk and we will do so immediately.

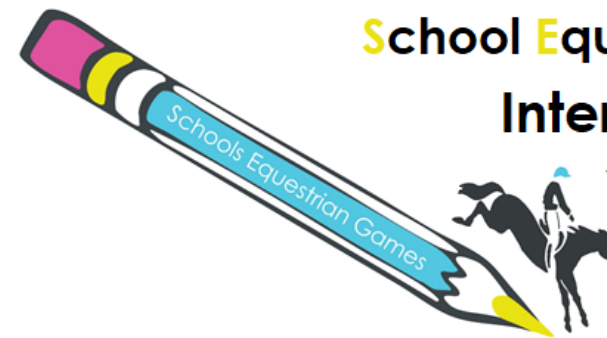
Personal Injury and Equipment Insurance Notice

Substitutions

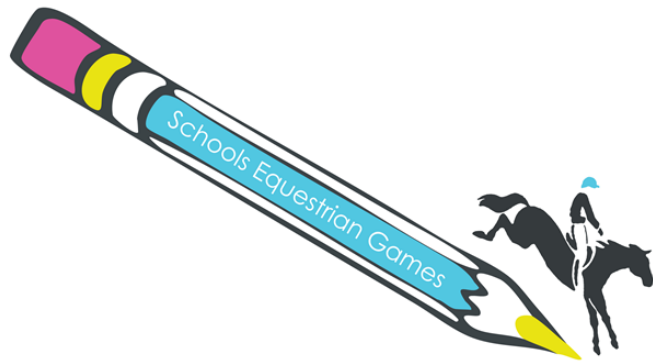
If substituting either a horse or rider there is a £5 admin charge after the closing date. Changing both horse and rider in the same entry qualifies as a new entry and must be paid in full. Substitution fees will be payable on the day.

ALL Withdrawals must be registered with entries secretary in writing or emailed. Please note if withdrawing after the closing date (Wednesday 8th May), in order to obtain your refund we MUST receive a vet's or doctor's certificate. Please send via email no later than the 20th May to obtain your refund.

Withdrawal policy depending on date of withdrawal:

1. Withdrawals for whatever reason before the closing date (Wednesday 8th May) will receive a full refund minus the £10 admin fee. Withdrawals after the closing date and before the withdrawal date (Monday 13th May 12 noon) for a veterinary or medical reason to the rider, if your place is replaced from our waitlist you will receive a full refund minus the £10 admin fee. If we are unable to fill your space a 50% refund is given.
2. Withdrawals made after the withdrawal date (Monday 13th May 12 noon) for a veterinary or medical reason to the rider, are non-refundable unless a replacement from our waitlist is found in this situation a full refund will be given minus the £10 admin fee.
3. Withdrawals made 24 hours before the event Starting for whatever reason are non-refundable.

Schools Equestrian Games

“Showcasing tomorrows equestrian talent”

We pride ourselves of well organised events with clear communication in a friendly and enjoyable atmosphere, providing a platform for all school children to compete in equestrian sport at all levels of competition.

The SEG Eventing Championships is a series of ODE's around the country to give children the opportunity to compete for their schools and qualify for the Schools Equestrian Games Eventing Championships.

This will be a prestigious new event for 2019 and will be the recognised Eventing Championships for all schools, we welcome international schools to compete as well.

How to Qualify

- Throughout the season the competitions are individual qualifiers -teams will then be made at the championships if schools have enough members from their school who have qualified individually to make up a team.
- Teams- Maximum of 2 teams per school per height at the championships.
- Top 8 qualify if section starters 30 or less, top 10 qualify if more than 30 starters per section.
- Qualification is passed down the line in the event that those placed have previously qualified.
- The same horse and rider combination qualify- no substitutions can be made.
- Each competitor rides for the school they currently attends - school leavers (17/18 years) ride for their previous school.
