Eligibility

Any Schools Equestrian Games event is open to all children attending school with consent from the head teacher to represent the school at competition (children home schooled can compete).

'SEG Registration Form'- this form is required to be completed online the first time your school is represented at an SEG competition before close of entries for the competition.

Only ONE form is required per school- a list of registered schools is available here if you are unsure whether your are registered.

Terms and Conditions

1. This Competition is run in accordance SEG Rules 2019. Please find on Horse Events Website
Any Differences will be stated on this schedule
2. It is compulsory that all riders wear hats/helmets up British Eventing standards. All hats must be tagged with a Horse-Events tag which can be done at the Secretary's tent on the day of the competition.
3. Riding is a risk sport and it is highly advised that all riders wear body protectors to the latest BETA standard.
4. It is compulsory that every person entering the Horse-Events venue who is under the age of 18 years of age is accompanied by a responsible adult.
5. Each Horse can be entered for a maximum of 2 round
6. NO dogs allowed
7. It is compulsory that horseboxes are not to be mucked out on site.
8. It is compulsory that all gates must be kept closed.
9. The Management of Horse-Events reserves the right to remove anyone from the course at any time without giving a reason.
9. The event may be cancelled without notice, due to adverse weather. In the event of adverse weather, it is recommended that you check on 07962 251 696 before departing.
10. All horses/ponies must be at least four years old.
11. In the event of a cancellation, entry fees will be returned minus £5 admin fee per rider.
12. Withdrawals before the closing date (4th February) will have their entry fees returned on receipt of a vet or doctor's certificate
Withdrawals after the closing date are non refundable for whatever reason
13. In the event of being oversubscribed a ballot in lines with the NSEA ruling will take place. If a Ballot takes place all schools will be notified if their entry is NOT successful. Entries will be refunded on to the card in which the entries were paid for.
