

RULES OF ENTRY:

1. This Event will be run under Pony Club 2019 Dressage Rules and Dengie Dressage Rules 2018/2019. Full Rules can be found at www.pcup.org
2. Only combinations who have qualified at a PC Dengie Winter League Preliminary Round may enter the qualifying classes.
3. Members must compete at their own Area Competition.
4. Pre Entry Only.
5. Numbers must be worn.
6. The Pony Club saddlery and dress rules apply at Area Competitions.
7. Hard hats must comply with current standards & must be worn at ALL times when mounted.
8. Commanders are not permitted in the qualifying classes.
9. Class 1 (Warm up class) may be called.
10. The Judge's decision is final.
11. Objections to be made to the Secretary within 15 minutes of final results, with £20 deposit. (Refunded if objection upheld).
12. The first three in each section, and any tying for these places will qualify for the Championships.
13. No hay nets or horses/ponies to be left tied to side lorries/trailers and left unattended.
14. Please make sure all droppings are removed before leaving. No mucking out.
15. No refunds will be made unless accompanied by Vet or Doctors report.
16. Horses must be 4 years old and over.
17. No lunging.
18. The Organisers and the Unicorn Equestrian Centre accept no responsibility for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, ponies, riders, grooms, and spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
19. No dogs allowed.
20. All children must be supervised by at all times. No playing in car park.
21. By entering a class the rider is agreeing to abide by the rules.

ELIGIBILITY RULES:

Open to all Pony Club Branch and Centre Members that fulfil the following criteria:

NOVICE .

Riders are NOT eligible

1. If they have represented a Branch or Centre at Open Area Dressage or above this includes Summer and /or Winter Area competitions.
2. Prelim Rounds: If they have won any BD (or DI) points at Novice level or above.
3. Area Competitions: If they have won more than 10 BD (or DI) points at Novice level or above.

INTERMEDIATE .

Combination of horse and rider are NOT eligible

1. If they have represented a Branch or Centre at Open Area Dressage or above this includes Summer and /or Winter Area competitions.
2. If they have won any BD (or DI) points at Elementary level or above. Or competed at Medium level.

OPEN CLASS:

Open to all Pony Club Branch and Centre Members.

Horses which have won more than 10 points at Advanced Medium level or above during the current year are not eligible.

This includes Hors Concours entries.
