**B)** Open to anyone not entering Section A

**CLASS 6: 1m – 1.05m** - Single phase. Open to individuals only.

**CLASS 7: 1.10m** – Table A7. Open to individuals only.

**A)** Dengie Area 9 Open Qualifier – open to all members of Branches/Centres in the Pony Club Area 9. First 3 Qualify for the Dengie Championships.

### ENTRY FEES:

Classes 1, 2, 3B, 4, 5B, 6, 7B- £14.00 per combination

Classes 3A, 5A and 7A (Dengie Area competitions) - £16.00 per combination

Please note there is a £1 non refundable booking fee added on to each class whether made online or by post

**FIRST AID CONTRIBUTION:** one off payment of £2 per combination of horse & rider

### QUALIFIERS:

Class 3A and 5A: Up to 40 starters; 4 to qualify. 41-50 starters, 5 to qualify.

Class 7: 3 to qualify.

Please notify secretary **ON THE DAY** if you are unable to compete at the Championships so that the qualification may be passed down.

**TEAM MANAGERS:** Please ensure that all your competitors are aware of the Rules and Notices. The Organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present. For these to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all officials and stewards.

**Closing date for entries – Noon on Sunday 10th March 2019:** entries will close earlier if full and a waiting list held. If you miss the closing date, please email the Entries Secretary for any available spaces. We are expecting to ballot in which case priority will be given to Dengie competitors.

### HATS

All competitors must wear hats to the following standard: PAS 015:1998 or 2011 with BSI Kitemark VG1, Snell E2001 with the official Snell label and number, ASTM-F1163 2004a with the SEI mark. AS/NZS 3838 2006.

**Parents should note that hat standard EN 1384 became obsolete from December 2015.**

**Hat Rule Amendment for 2018:** To unify hat standards The Pony Club, BE, & BRC will introduce a new “aquamarine” tag. White tags will no longer be accepted at PC events, competitions & rallies and members should seek to re-tag from now. Please refer to your own DC or Centre Proprietor for full details.

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## RULES AND NOTICES

1. Teams to be made up of 3 or 4 combinations, with the best three scores to count.
2. Substitutions allowed – please tell the Entries/Show Secretaries by email or on the day. No substitutions permitted for Dengie classes.
3. Dengie Area Competitions – if there is equality for qualifying places then a jump off will decide.
4. **TEAM MANAGERS:** please enter teams in order of preference – if we have to limit entries then those higher in the list will be given priority. Times online for accepted entries on horse-events.co.uk
5. Pre-entries are essential as entries will be limited. If you miss the closing date please ring/email the Entries Secretary for available spaces. A waiting list will be held if necessary.
6. **Closing date for entries – Noon Sunday 10th March 2019.**  
Withdrawal refunds given on receipt of a relevant doctor/vet certificate received by the Entries Secretary by 31st March 2019 (please enclose an s.a.e.)
7. If the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, entry fees will be refunded on receipt of an s.a.e. by 31st March 2019. *Any refund may be subject to an administration fee*
8. **TIMES FOR CLASS 1 WILL BE GIVEN AND STRICTLY ADHERED TO and there will be a drawn order for other classes** – please see horse-events.co.uk from Thursday 14th March 2019 after 6pm, or contact the Entries Secretary on/after 14th March or send a 1st class s.a.e. with entry. Approximate times for the course walk prior to the other classes will be given. It must be stressed that times are approximate; please arrive in plenty of time.
9. Competitor numbers MUST be visible at all times whilst mounted.
10. Indoor warm-up arenas – the number of competitors will be restricted; please obey the steward's instructions as to when you can use each of the indoor warm-up arenas.
11. Children should not jump in either warm-up arena without a steward present.
12. Each horse/pony may only compete once in each class and in a maximum of three classes. No stallions. All horse/ponies must be at least 5 years old on day of competition.
13. Turnout for ALL riders and horses should be as in the Pony Club Rules for Show-jumping 2019. Please contact the Entries Secretary BEFORE the show day for any queries re dress/turnout. Rules are on the main Pony Club website.
14. **SPURS:** ALL spurs worn anywhere on the showground, by any competitor, must comply with Pony Club rules.
15. Any abuse of horses/ponies, officials, other competitors or members of the public will not be tolerated and those found doing so will be asked to leave the venue with no compensation and may be reported to the relevant authority.
16. Judges' decision is final. Any objection must be handed to the Show Secretary in writing with a £20 deposit (which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld) within 15 minutes of the incident and BEFORE the prize-giving for that class.
17. **INSURANCE:** please ensure that you have adequate/appropriate insurance for rider, horse, property and third party.
18. **PHOTOGRAPHS:** by entering this competition you are agreeing to be photographed whilst competing; these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not wish to be photographed please tell the photographer on entering the arena.
19. Participants attend at their own risk; neither the Committee nor Hartpury College will be liable for any loss, damage or accident to horses, riders, property or other persons.
20. No horses/ponies should be left tied to the outside of trailers/lorries without supervision. Please clear any muck/rubbish and do not leave on the lorry park.
21. The show will be run under Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2019  
Due to Health and Safety regulations, all competitors will be judged under Pony Club rules and it is the competitors' responsibility to familiarize themselves with these rules. All competitors will have a tack check before competing.

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
