ACCESS only via MARKYATE:
Directions:

From M1 Junction 9, take A5 to Dunstable. After approx 2.5 miles take
left turn into HICKS ROAD (just after pedestrian footbridge) into MARKYATE.
At end of Hicks Road, TURN RIGHT, then immediately TURN LEFT into PICKFORD ROAD.
Follow Pickford Road for approx 2 miles.
Field entrance on left side opposite entrance to Beechwood Park School

CLASS 1: 50cm New XC shortened on part of the main course

Riders aged 10 years and under (on 01.01.2019),

Dressage Test: **Pony Club D Level 2012** (walk and trot) (may be commanded)

Show Jumping and XC 50cm. Competitors may be accompanied on XC course only **but must declare** in case of splitting classic sufficient entries

Competitors will be **allowed** to complete the course following elimination.

CLASS 1A: 50cm Team

Teams to consist of 3-4 members from class 1. Best 3 scores to count.

CLASS 2: 60cm

Section A: Riders aged 12 and under (on 01.01.2019), not to have won a ODE at this level

Section B: Riders aged 13 and over, combination not to have won a ODE at this level

Dressage Test: **Pony Club Level C 2012** (may be commanded, will incur 5 penalties)

Show Jumping 65cm, and XC 60cm approx. XC on main course.

Competitors will be **allowed** to complete the course following elimination.

CLASS 2A: 60 cm Team

Teams to consist of 3-4 members from class 2. Best 3 scores to count.

CLASS 3: PC 80

Section A: Combination not to have won a ODE at this level

Section B: Open to all

Dressage Test: **Pony Club Grassroots Dressage test 2018**

Show Jumping max 85cm, XC max 80cm

Competitors will be asked to **leave** the course following elimination.

CLASS 3A: PC 80 Team

Team to consist of 3-4 members from class 3. Best 3 scores to count.

CLASS 4: PC 90

Riders any age.

Dressage: **Pony Club 90 Eventing Test 2013**

Show Jumping max 95cm, XC max 90cm

Competitors will be asked to **leave** the course following elimination.

CLASS 4A: PC 90 Team

Team to consist of 3-4 members from class 4. Best 3 scores to count.

CLASS 5: PC 100

Riders any age

Dressage: **Pony Club 100 Eventing Test 2015**

Show Jumping max 105cm, and XC 100

If entries for this class are too low, then it will be amalgamated with class 4.

Competitors will be asked to **leave** the course following elimination.

ENTRY FEES: All Entries close midnight Sunday 9th June 2019 - First aid cover included.

CLASS : 1 : £22 (£18 FPC members) first aid cover included

CLASSES : 2, 3, 4, 5 : £40 per class (£35 FPC Members)

TEAMS: £10 per team

Minimum £5 deposit (cash only in named envelope) will be required on the day for number bibs.

Teams to consist of 3 - 4 competitors in the same class. All must be entered as individuals too. Best 3 scores to count. Names of Team Riders must be declared on the Team Entry Form with payment

PRIZES:

The top two overall scores in each class to receive a special prize

Rosettes to 8th place in each class/ section plus special prize for the highest placed Flamstead member in each class.

A rosette for the best dressage test in each class/section. Rosettes to 3rd place in Team Competition.

GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

MEDICAL ARM BANDS REQUIRED FOR XC AS WELL AS BACK PROTECTORS TO THE CURRENT PC STANDARDS : BETA 2009 Level 3 (PURPLE LABEL)

1. Entry to any Flamstead Branch of the Pony Club competition authorises photographs/ videos/other images taken by outside agencies/official Pony Club photographers at the competition to be published in the press and on the internet for publicity purposes.
2. All competitions will be run in accordance with the current guidelines set by the Pony Club for 2019, modified where applicable.
3. No competitor will be allowed to compete unless their riding hat complies with the current Pony Club standards. (See www.pcuk.org) All competitors' hats to be tagged by THEIR own branch. A jockey skull cap with no fixed peak must be worn for the cross country phase.
4. Objections to the Secretary, in writing, within one hour of the incident with a £10 deposit. Deposit will be returned if objection is upheld.
5. The decision of the Judge is final. A competitor may be disqualified for the improper use of whips, spurs or bad language. Spurs may only be worn by Pony Club members who have written consent from their District Commissioner.
6. **Neither the organiser, landowner, nor any person acting on their behalf accept any liability for loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever. The organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.**
7. No horse or pony under 5 years of age may compete.
8. All dogs must be on a lead (extendable leads locked short) at all times.
9. No mucking out of horse boxes and trailers is permitted in the lorry/car park.
10. All ages as on 1st January 2019
11. No entry fee will be refunded unless accompanied by a doctor's or vet's certificate. In the event of cancellation of the competition, entry fees will be refunded, less £5 per entry to be retained by Flamstead Pony Club to cover costs.
12. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry or vary or cancel the event without explanation.
13. After elimination rider may continue at the discretion of the fence judge, but if told to do so must leave the course at a walk.
14. A horse or pony may only enter a max two classes.
15. **IT IS THE COMPETITORS' RESPONSIBILITY TO ENSURE THEIR DRESS AND TACK COMPLIES WITH PONY CLUB REGULATIONS 2018 FOR THE DISCIPLINE THEY ARE TAKING PART IN. COMPETITORS FOUND IN BREACH OF THESE REGULATIONS MAY BE DISQUALIFIED AT ANY TIME DURING OR AFTER THE COMPETITION.**
16. During Cross Country Phase Medical armbands must be worn on the rider's arm or the shoulder protector/pad of their body protector. Body protectors are compulsory. If a rider chooses to wear a Point Two Air Jacket it must only be used in addition to a normal body protector & they must bring their own number bibs which should have elastic rather than ties. Riders who choose the Woof Wear Exo body cage must lodge a key with the Event Organiser when they collect their number. Medical armbands will be for sale on the day. Stop watches may not be used.
17. NO HORSES OR PONIES TO LEFT UNATTENDED OUTSIDE TRAILERS OR LORRIES.
