There will be an Optimum Time set at equivalent PC eventing speed.

No horse/pony may compete in more than two classes.

There will be a tack check in the collecting ring.

<b>Class 2 Pre Novice – Pony Club</b>	PC80 10yrs/over Fences 75-85cm approx.
<b>Class 3 Pre Novice – Non PC</b>	PC80 10yrs/over Fences 75-85cm approx.
<b>Class 4 Pairs</b>	PC90 10yrs/over Fences 90cm approx.
<b>Class 5 Novice – Pony Club</b>	PC90 10yrs/over Fences 90cm approx.
<b>Class 6 Novice – Non PC</b>	PC90 10yrs/over Fences 90cm approx.
<b>Class 7 Intermediate – PC</b>	PC100 10yrs/over Fences 100cm approx.
<b>Class 8 Intermediate – Non PC</b>	PC100 10yrs/over Fences 100cm approx.
<b>Class 9 Open</b>	PC110 12yrs/over Fences 110cm approx. This class will be split PC & Non PC if entries permit

## GENERAL CONDITIONS

Courses will be open for inspection Saturday 28 March from 2pm to 4.30pm. The Park will be locked at 6pm.

Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.

Judged under Pony Club Eventing Rules 2020 relating to xc. Rules can be viewed and downloaded from [www.pcuk.org](http://www.pcuk.org).

### **Rider's age as at 1<sup>st</sup> January 2020.**

Body protectors BETA 2009 Level 3 (Purple) tag are compulsory.

All hats worn by competitors must comply with Pony Club Rules which can be viewed at [www.pcuk.org](http://www.pcuk.org). Hat tagging will be available at the Secretary's tent on the day. Fixed peak hats are not allowed.

The decision of the judges is final and any objections must be made to the organiser with a deposit of £20, refundable if the objection is upheld.

L fences incur 15 penalties.

Competitors may compete on two horse/ponies if time permits.

Pairs class – competitors need not jump side by side, but **neither member must attempt the next fence until their partner has cleared the previous fence**. Pairs do not need to be in the same PC branch.

It is not permitted to ride elsewhere in the Park. Any rider doing so will be eliminated from the competition and asked to leave. Any prizes will be forfeited.
