All classes will be decided using a bogey time

CLASS 1

Super Mini

Approx. height 30cm

Will be over a shortened course and completely enclosed in a field/roped arena.

Lead rein and assistance may be given.

Entry fee for class 1 - £20

CLASS 2

Minimus Pairs

Approx height 45cm

Will be over a slightly shortened course.

Lead rein and assistance may be given.

Entry fee for class 2 - £32 per pair

CLASS 3

Minimus

Approx height 45cm

Will be over a slightly shortened course.

Lead rein and assistance may be given.

Entry fee for class 3 - £20

CLASS 4

Pairs

Approx height 55cm

Entry fee for class 4 - £35 per pair

CLASS 5

Approx. height 55cm

Entry fee for class 5 - £22

Approx height 75cm

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF ENTRY

1. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that the organisers, the landowner, or his agents shall not be held responsible for any loss, injury or damage to competitors, onlookers, or their property, howsoever caused.
2. Correct attire, including a hard hat to current safety standards, must be worn at all times when mounted.
3. Body protectors are recommended but not compulsory for Showjumping but are compulsory for cross country.
4. The organisers reserve the right to cancel the show, alter classes, judges, time, or any of the published information.
5. Horses, ponies, and riders must be 4 years and over.
6. No horses, ponies, or children to be left unattended.
7. Please clear up any droppings/hay by lorry/trailer prior to leaving.
8. No lunging.
9. It is a deemed a condition of entry that all competitors have inspected the ground/surface prior to entering and are happy to proceed.
- 10.No dogs.
- 11.All riders have assessed the courses and have entered a class they deem within their capabilities.

RULES RELATING TO COVID-19

- 1. Please if you are displaying any symptoms of COVID-19 DO NOT ATTEND. Your entry will be held over for another competition.**
- 2. We ask that you come, ride your test/s, and then leave. We will post all the results as quickly as we can on our Facebook page and post all test sheets and rosettes to you.**
- 3. There will only be 3 riders in the warm at any one time, there will be a strict one-way system in place so that we can adhere to the social distancing guidelines.**
- 4. Please be aware that we are currently following sporting guidelines and limiting support to one person, per rider, per horse, and in the case of a rider with multiple horses this will be one supporter allowed per horse.**
- 5. As the guidelines are changing all the time, these may be subject to change so please be aware of this.**
