

Cumbria MGA Pairs Competitions @ Harrogate EC – Nth Yorkshire

CLASSES:

UNDER 12: Each rider must be under the age of 12 as at 1st January 2022

UNDER 15: Each rider must be under the age of 15 as at 1st January 2022

UNDER 18/OPEN: u18 - Each rider must be under the age of 18 as at 1st January 2022
Open any age

INDIVIDUALS: Any age

Both names of the pair must be provided on entry, or name of individual. If one member of the pair has to drop out, the other rider must go back on the waiting list and the place will be offered to the next pair on the waiting list unless a veterinary or doctor's certificate is produced.

ENTRIES:

– Entries in each class are restricted and will be dealt with strictly on a first come, first served basis. Entries close 1st February 2022. Times will be out a week before on Cumbria Mounted Games FB page

– PLACES CANNOT BE RESERVED BY TELEPHONE OR EMAIL.

– RIDERS MUST ENTER AS A PAIR – NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED WITH ONLY ONE NAME.

– Places CANNOT be reserved without full payment.

– Full competition details, including games, timings, etc. will be issued to all riders nearer to the date of the competition and will be available on the Cumbria Mounted Games Face book page

– All competitors must be members of MGA(GB) Ltd. or pay temporary membership – please download the temporary membership form – <http://mgagb.co.uk/membership/temporary-membership/> and send with the entry form.

– Closing dates for entries is : These will be sooner if spaces fill.

ENTRY FEES:

Entry fee is £70 per pair. £35 per individual
entry online only at horse events. (there is a small booking fee)

GAMES & RULES:

There will be 1 heat (8 races) and final (8 races min). If only 1 heat points will carry forwards

All games and rules will be found in the 2021 IMGA Rule book.

We aim to start at 8/830am with u12/u15, U18/open will be after midday

RIDERS WILL BE DEEMED TO HAVE ACCEPTED THE RULES BY ENTERING THE COMPETITION.

LIABILITY:

Neither the Organisers, nor any person acting on their behalf, accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, illness or injury to ponies, horses or any other person or property whatsoever.

INSURANCE:

All members of MGA(GB) Ltd. are covered by the Association's Third Party Public Liability Policy. It is up to each rider to insure him/herself and their pony or property.

REFUNDS:

There will be no cancellation refunds after the closing date . Unless a Veterinary Certificate or Doctor's letter is produced. (this includes a PCR covid result which must be sent for a refund – lateral flow not accepted)

REFUSAL:

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry into the competition or refuse admittance to the Showground. No reason will be given for so doing.
