SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

The first class will start at 9am. The course will be ready for walking at 8.30am and between classes.

CLASS 1: Very Low jumps. Lead rein or may be assisted

The assistant may touch the rider and/or pony with no penalty.

CLASS 2: 30cm Show Jumping. Lead rein or may be assisted.

The assistant may touch the rider and/or pony with no penalty.

CLASS 3: 40cm Show Jumping. Lead rein or may be assisted.

In all classes the course will be "single phase" with riders jumping one course (no separate jump off). The second section of the course will be timed and used to decide placings for riders finishing on the same number of faults. Faults will be cumulative over the whole course.

Rules and Conditions of Entry

Your entry is deemed to include acceptance of these rules

1. The competition will be run in accordance with the Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2021.
2. The Judge's decision is final.
4. Protests and Objections - please see Pony Club Show Jumping Rule book 2021
4. Horses/ponies competing may only be ridden by their competitor, at the venue.
5. Classes 1-3: a pony may be ridden no more than twice in each class.
6. Combinations can enter no more than three classes.
7. No horse or pony may enter more than three classes.
8. Spurs may be worn in accordance with the Show jumping Rules 2021
9. No horse/pony under the age of 5 may compete.

NUMBERS SHOULD BE PRINTED BY COMPETITORS and may be used in a number bib or attached to the saddlecloth; numbers should be printed as large as possible. There is a tool to print your number on A4 online using: [Horse Events numbers](#)

Entries and Refunds

1. In the event of cancellation by the organisers, refund in full less booking fee. Refunds will be paid online via Horse Events. No refunds in other circumstances.
2. **No substitutions can be made after the competition has started.**
4. A booking fee will be added to each entry.

Rider and Public Safety

1. All hats must comply to the current PC safety standards
2. When not competing all horses/ponies must be kept in the horse box park or collecting rings. They must not be exercised in the car/lorry park, or among spectators. **No lunging allowed at the venue.**
3. Horses/ponies tied to trailers or lorries must not be left unattended.
4. **Please leave dogs at home.**

Event Liability

1. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. *Entries are only accepted on this basis.*
2. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of officials and stewards.
