WITHDRAWALS AND REFUNDS

If a Branch or Centre withdraws a team or Individual prior to the entry closing date, a full refund of entry will be made less an administration charge.

Withdrawals after the closing date for a competition will not be refunded except on production of a vet certificate or medical certificate.

Refunds where due after the closing date are subject to an administration fee of £5.

In the event of the competition being abandoned, for whatever reason, a refund of 50% of the entry will be given.

[RULES](#)

- All riders/teams must present themselves to the tack steward at least 10 minutes before their start time for tack inspection (as permitted by Covid 19 guidelines). Please note individuals/team managers should ensure their tack is safe.
- Each class is open to individuals and teams of 3 or 4 members with the best three scores to count. Teams will be made up from different pony clubs but priority will be given to teams with all members from the same club.
- This competition will include a variety of show jumps and cross country style jumps. It will be run as a single phase with show jumps and cross country. All competitors proceed to timed section whether faults have been incurred or not, unless you have been ELIMINATED.
- Scoring will be on Pony Club Results.
- The winner being the closest to the optimum time and with the least faults.
- We will be adhering to the Covid 19 guidelines current at the time of the competition.
- There will be a designated person in the practice arena to help the competitors.
- No other parents or helpers will be allowed into the practice arena except in Class 1.
- Course walks will take place in regular intervals throughout the day.
- We ask that dogs are left at home. Please clear any hay and droppings around your trailers.
- This competition will be run under Pony Club Eventing General Rules 2020. The judges decision will be final.
- No rider may ride more than one horse/pony in any one team. No horse/pony can be ridden in more than two classes.
- All hats **MUST NOT** be fixed peak and must comply with current Pony Club Rule Book. Failure to comply may result in elimination. Hats must be tagged with the aquamarine tag.
- **Body Protectors BETA 2009 (LEVEL 3) purple label compulsory.**
- Horses/ponies must be 5 years old and over.
- LEGAL LIABILITY Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the Organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the Organisers of any event to which these rules apply, nor the Pony Club, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
- The Organisers of this Event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all the Officials and Stewards.
