

RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

No dogs allowed on site

Strictly No Smoking

1. All Classes are run in accordance with the Pony Club Dressage Rule Book 2020 and the PC Spring Festival 2022 Rules.
2. All Pony Club members must wear British Standard approved hardhats to standard: PAS 015 or 2011, VCI, Snell E2001, AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards or ATSM F1163 with SEI mark.
3. Non members are allowed to compete in the Preliminary Rounds but must be paid up members to compete at the Area Competition.
4. Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of any event to which these rules apply, nor the Pony Club, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
5. All non-Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The New Forest Hunts Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover you.
6. In the event of cancellation, entry fees will be refunded less £2. No entry will be refunded without a doctor's or a vet's certificate.
7. The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organiser and all Officials and Stewards. Relevant Covid restrictions at the time of competition will apply. If you have any signs of Covid or have tested positive in the previous 10 days you must NOT attend.
8. All tests may be commanded.
9. Clear up all droppings and hay. Hay nets not to be hung outside of trailers.
10. **Parents/Guardians – please supervise your children at all times and do not allow children to be noisy alongside the arena. Thank you.**

- If they have represented a Branch/Centre at Open Area Dressage or above (this includes summer and/or winter Area Competitions).

OPEN TO ALL: **Section A Open, Section B Qualifier**

FOR PC qualifiers - Horses/ponies are NOT eligible:

- If they have won more than 10 points at Advanced Medium level or above during the current year (this includes Hors Concours entries).

Non members may compete in the preliminary rounds of the festival qualifiers but need to become members in order to compete at the Area Qualifier.
