6 MINIMUS BOYS 11 and under

7m turning shoot 2 handed, 2 min swim, 1,000m run

7 TADPOLE GIRLS 9 and under

7m static shoot 2 handed, 2 min swim, 1,000m run

8 TADPOLE BOYS 9 and under

7m static shoot 2 handed, 2 min swim, 1,000m run

9 BEANIE TRIATHLON 7 and under

Throw, 1 min swim, 500m run

10 BEANIE BIATHLON 7 and under

Throw, 500m run

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****IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR SWIMMING****

Buoyancy aids are not permitted as per Pony Club rules,
therefore competitors must be capable of swimming a length and out of their depth.
For those Beanies who are not capable of swimming, we have the Beanie Biathlon class.

ENTRY FEES:

Classes 1 – 9: £18

Class 10: £10

Closing date for entries: Saturday 19th February.

Entries will be via Horse Events. All entries are subject to a non-refundable booking fee which will be stated online on a per class basis.

Entries will only be processed following confirmation from either the Branch DC or Tetrathlon Co-ordinator that the competitor has received training in the use of an air pistol from a suitably qualified shooting instructor and that they can swim safely.

Times will be posted on Northern England Tetrathlon and Pony Club Tetrathlon Facebook Groups.
