SATURDAY 9TH JULY 2022

Class 1 – 70cms – A round of Show Jumping (max 70cms) immediately followed by a shortened cross country course (max 70cms).

Class 2 – 80cms - A round of Show Jumping (max 80cms) immediately followed by a shortened cross country course (max 80cms).

SUNDAY 10TH JULY 2022

Class 3 – 90cms - A round of Show Jumping (max 90cms) immediately followed by a shortened cross country course (max 90cms).

Class 4 – 100cms - A round of Show Jumping (max 100cms) immediately followed by a shortened cross country course (max 100cms).

Each class will be split into sections, depending on entries, this may include Junior and Senior sections. Please confirm age (if under 18) when entering. Maximum 2 classes per horse/rider combination.

Pre-entries only. Entries close 2nd July 2022. Times will be given and available on brightlingpark.com and Brightling Park Horse Trials Facebook page by evening of 7th July 2022.

RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All riders MUST wear protective hats to Riding Club/Pony Club standards at all times when mounted. Body protectors must be worn and to Riding Club/Pony club standards. Please see the current hat/body protector rules on the Riding Club website—www.bhs.org.uk.
2. The Judge's decision is final.
3. Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of any event to which these rules apply, nor the pony club, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
4. The organisers reserve the right to cancel and alter classes, refuse entries without explanation and to disqualify competitors.
5. No entry money will be refunded after close of entries without a Vet/Doctor's certificate.
6. No entry will be accepted without the appropriate fee.
7. Objection may be raised within 15 minutes of the incident, in writing, accompanied by a deposit of £10, returnable if the objection is upheld.
8. ALL dogs must be on a short lead.
9. All horses/ponies must be 4yrs old or over on the day of the event.
10. No horse or pony to be tied to a trailer or lorry unattended.

Health & Safety

Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
