Please note you do **NOT** have to be a member of British Eventing to compete in these classes.

**CLASS 1: Arena Eventing – 80cm Level**  
Height approx. **80cms** Entry Fee: £50.00

**CLASS 2: Arena Eventing – 90cm Level**  
Height approx. **90cms** Entry Fee: £50.00

**PRIZES:** £85, £70, £55, £40, £15 etc in the ratio of 1 prize for every 5 (completed) starters. Rosettes 1st – 10th

## **TWO PHASE COMPETITION**

### **FIRST PHASE – SHOW JUMPING**

Speed 325mpm with time allowed Approx. 9 fences

Knock down	5 penalties
First refusal	5 penalties
Second refusal	10 penalties
Third refusal	Elimination
Fall of horse or rider	Elimination
Exceeding time allowed	Elimination

### **SECOND PHASE – CROSS COUNTRY**

Speed 350mpm with a 10 second time window Approx. 9 fences

First refusal	20 penalties
Second refusal	40 penalties
Third refusal	Elimination
Fall of horse or rider	Elimination
There will be an optimum time in this section with a 10 second window Any time UNDER optimum – 1 penalty per sec Any time OVER optimum - 1 penalty per sec above the 10 second window	
Time penalties will not be incurred within the 10 second window but the ranking will be decided on those with ZERO penalties closest to the optimum time

**NUMBERS** Please print your own numbers to be worn in a bib.

**REFUNDS** No refund of entry fees will be made after closing date of entries unless replaced from the Wait List.

**PASSES** 1 horsebox pass and 2 admission tickets will be issued to each competitor by email. DC's and Team Trainers will also be issued with admission passes. All other spectators will have free entry to the PC SJ Arena, but will have to pay to access the main arena/trade stands area. **VACCINATIONS:** All horses must have an up-to-date flu vaccination certificate available at the event, as per the rules for British Eventing 2022.

**COMPETITORS:** must be age 12 years or over at the time of the competition  
Body Protectors and crash Hats are mandatory and must meet the current British Eventing standards (a BETA approved and labelled "level 3 body protector2 showing 2009 or 2018, manufactured after 2009, or an Exo Body Cage which must be declared to the Event Secretary beforehand. Hats – PAS 015 (1998 or 2011) with BSI Kitemark or Ispec IC Mark) Please refer to the British Eventing Rule Book 2022 for details.

**HORSES:** must be at least 137cm in height to compete in the 80cm and 142cm in height to compete in the 90cm class

**VENUE:** Gatcombe Park, Hampton Fields, Minchinhampton, Stroud, Glos, GL6 9AT

From the M4:

J15 follow A419 to Stroud.

J17 follow A429 to Malmesbury and B4014 through Tetbury.

J18 follow A46 to Stroud, follow signs to Minchinhampton.

From M5:

J13 follow A419 to Stroud then follow signs to the event.
