Withdrawals and refunds

After the closing date no refunds will be made without a Doctor's or Vet's certificate, produced no later than 24 hours after the event. If produced after this, no refund will be given. Refunds, where due, after the closing date are subject to an admin fee of £10.

In the event of abandonment 50% of the entry fee will be refunded.

Entry Conditions

- To be run in accordance with **Pony Club Eventing Rules 2022**
- Please ensure your members comply with **2022 eligibility**, hat tagging, body protector and responsible adult present.
- Competitors must ensure their **numbers** are downloaded and printed from the link on [PonyClubResults](#) when times are published. Two numbers, front and back, must be worn at all times whilst mounted.
- Competitors must bring their own **number bib**.
- **Queries** may only be raised via the Secretary by the DC/Centre Proprietor or their appointee. Protests / objections will be managed as per Eventing Rule book 2022.
- **No horse** will be allowed to compete in 2 classes.
- **Photographic Rights** – competitors and their parents/guardians have given permission for any photographic and/or film or TV footage taken of persons or horses/ponies taking part in Pony Club events to be used and published in any media whatsoever for editorial purposes, press information or advertising by or on behalf of the Pony Club and/or Official Sponsors of the Pony Club.

- A valid **passport and vaccination** record must accompany the horse/pony to this event and must be available for inspection if required by event officials. Vaccinations must be in accordance with the current Pony Club vaccination rules 2022 – **please refer to the website.**

- **Form A:** Please provide potential entry numbers from your Branch/Centre as accurately as possible. If entries are high, each Branch/Centre may have to be limited to 2 teams, with 2 individuals in the oversubscribed classes. These forms will enable us to timetable as many entries as possible.
