All Hunter Trial classes open to members and non-members

ARENA COURSE starting at 9.30am.

These classes will be held in the show jumping arena over a working hunter type course which will be

as rustic as possible. The tetrathlon courses will include a slip rail.

- CLASS 1** Clear round 40cm Entry fee £5 payable on day
- CLASS 2** TETRATHLON CLASSES A & B (Beanies) at 40cm, enter via Tetrathlon schedule
- CLASS 3** Clear round 60cm Entry fee £5 payable on day
- CLASS 4** TETRATHLON CLASSES C & D (Tadpoles) at 60cm, enter via Tetrathlon schedule

- CLASS 5** 70 cm PAIRS Hunter Trial. Rider any age. Qualifier
- CLASS 6a** 70 cm OPEN Hunter Trial. Rider any age. Qualifier
- CLASS 6b** 70cm PC Members Hunter Trial. Qualifier
- CLASS 7** 80cm PAIRS Hunter Trial. Rider any age Fences approx 80cm. Qualifier
- CLASS 8a** 80cm OPEN Hunter Trial. Rider any age Qualifier
- CLASS 8b** 80cm PC Members Hunter Trial. Cup for best EHPC member 12 years & under. Qualifier
- CLASS 9** TETRATHLON CLASSES E & F (Minimus) Fences approx 80cm, enter via Tetrathlon schedule
- CLASS 10a** 90cm OPEN Hunter Trial. Rider any age. Qualifier
- CLASS 10B** 90cm PC Hunter Trial Qualifier Lady of Sark Cup to highest placed EHPC member.
- CLASS 11** TETRATHLON CLASSES G & H (Juniors) Fences approx 90cm, enter via Tetrathlon schedule

CLASS 12 **TETRATHLON CLASSES I & J (Seniors)** Fences approx **1m**, enter via Tetrathlon schedule

CLASS 13 **OPEN Hunter Trial. Rider any age.** Fences approx **1m** **Qualifier**

ENTRY FEES: **Classes 5 & 7 £45 per pair**
 Classes 6, 8, 10 & 13 Pony Club members £30, non members £35.
 NO REFUNDS.

ROSETTES: Rosettes to highest placed Easton Harriers members and rosettes to 10th place in all classes.

ENTRIES CLOSE: Tuesday 9th April 2024.

COURSE: The course may be walked from 2pm on Saturday 13nd April 2024.

RULES

1. The rules of the Pony Club Eventing & Tetrathlon 2024 will be applied throughout, with variations as deemed appropriate by the organisers. See rules 2 and 12 below.
2. Individual classes: Times, distances and speeds will be on the course plan.
Pairs classes: Winners will be pair with least number of style points with the least number of jumping penalties. In the event of equality, time will be taken into consideration.
3. Hats must conform to the new Hat Rule and **carry a PINK tag.**

4. For Cross-country riding over fences 80cm high and above a jockey skull cap with no fixed peak must be worn. It is strongly recommended that a jockey skull cap is worn for cross country riding over lower fences.
5. Body Protectors must be worn on the cross country course. The responsibility for choosing a body protector rests with members and their parents. It is recommended that a rider's body protector should not be more than 2% of their body weight. **New Body Protector Rule** <https://branches.pcuk.org/westhants/files/2024/01/body-protector-rule-2024.pdf>
6. Entries and the number of horses per rider may be limited.
7. All horses must be at least 5 years old.
8. **Health and Safety.** Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be

effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
