Eligibility:

All under 13s on the day of the ride must have a mounted adult (over 18 years old). Accompanying adults entering FOC will not be eligible for the Intro to Endurance badge and therefore any older (non-)members being used as escort riders who wish to achieve the badge must make a separate entry. Please make it clear on the under-13s entry who their accompanying rider will be.

Accompanying adults can escort a maximum of 2 children.

The Endurance Fun Ride can count towards the Intro to Endurance Badge for non-members if they subsequently become members.

Entries:

All entries should be made online using www.horse-events.co.uk.

All entries are subject to a non-refundable booking fee as stated online.

This is a single booking form process, and entries will not be confirmed without payment.

For Pony Club entries you will need your membership number and the name of your Branch/Centre.

If you would like to edit your entry details before the closing date of the event, please log in to your Horse-Events account and edit your booking under the "My Booking" tab.

Please ensure the competitor complies with eligibility, dress, and saddlery requirements.

A valid passport and vaccination record must accompany the horse/pony to this event and must be available for inspection if required by event officials. Vaccinations must be in accordance with the Pony Club Vaccination Rule.

Queries may only be raised via the event organiser by the DC/Centre Proprietor or their appointee. Protests/objections will be managed as per the PC Endurance Rulebook 2024.

Timetable

<u>Sunday 11th August 13:00 – 15:30</u>

The opportunity for members and non-members to take part in a fun ride round the site of The Pony Club Championships. The ride is approx. 6km covering sections of the cross-country course, a water crossing and fields. For members, there will be the opportunity to achieve the Intro to Endurance Pony Club badge with a trot up and 'vet-check' at the start and end of the ride. Non-members will be able to participate in this and will gain a Certificate which can then be used for the Intro to Endurance award once they become a Member.

Times will be allocated within the hour slot selected on your entry. Accompanying adult, if with a separate entry, needs to select the same timeslot as the u13 entrant.

You may ride in groups. There is a limit of **12 entries per half hour** and entry to time slots is first come first served. We will try our best to accommodate your wishes, so if you are unable to all enter the same time slot, please enter two time slots next to each other and specify who you want to ride with. To make the event as enjoyable as possible for everyone, we ask that groups are no larger than six.

<u>Sunday 11th August 15:30 – 17:00</u>

This slot is for lead-rein horses/ponies only. Leaders must be over 18. Only lead rein horses/ponies will be on the course at this time.

Intro to Endurance Badge

Members and non-members wishing to take part in the Intro to Endurance Badge should familiarise themselves with the <u>syllabus</u> prior to the event.

Substitutions:

Withdrawals & Refunds:

WITHDRAWALS (ALL COMPETITIONS & CHAMPIONSHIPS)
