SECTION A – TURNOUT.

ENTRY FEE £7.00 (C.F.P.C. members £6.00)

The classes will be judged at the same time as the Equitation class. From 9.30a.m.

- Class 1 Best turnout, riders 10 years and under on or off lead rein
- Class 2 Best turnout, riders 11 - 15 year
- Class 3 Best turnout, riders 16 years and over.

SECTION B - EQUITATION CLASSES 9.30 a.m.

ENTRY FEE £7.00 (C.F.P.C. members £6.00)

These classes will be judged at the same time as the Turnout class.

- Class 4 Riders 10 years and under on or off lead rein
- Class 5 Riders 11-15 years
- Class 6 Riders 16 years and over

N. B. Once judging has commenced competitors will not be allowed to enter the ring

SECTION C - SHOW JUMPING

ENTRY FEE £8.00 (C.F.P.C. members £7.00)

Show Jumping will not commence before 11.00 am

- Class 7 Beginners Poles on floor (assistance allowed) No Elimination
- Class 8 Beginners on or off lead rein fences very small Not to exceed 30cm (assistance allowed) No Elimination
- Class 9 Beginners 40cm (assistance allowed) No Elimination
- Class 10 Ponies – fences not to exceed 50 cm
- Class 11 Horses – fences not to exceed 50 cm
- Class 12 Ponies – fences not to exceed 60 cm
- Class 13 Horses – fences not to exceed 60 cm
- Class 14 Ponies – fences not to exceed 70 cm
- Class 15 Horses – fences not to exceed 70 cm
- Class 16 Ponies – fences not to exceed 80 cm
- Class 17 Horses – fences not to exceed 80 cm
- Class 18 Ponies – fences not to exceed 90 cm
- Class 19 Horses – fences not to exceed 90 cm
- Class 20 Ponies – fences not to exceed 1m
- Class 21 Horses – fences not to exceed 1m
