Class Schedule:

All classes will be run with two rounds.

The PC 70 and PC 80 second rounds will be run as single phase (no jump off) .

The PC110 will have two sections – Pony Section and Horse Section.

The PC90, PC100 & PC110 will jump two separate rounds per class, and will have a separate jump off for those on equal faults in qualifying places.

If a combination qualifies for both individual & team jump off they will only need to jump once in jump off.

Pre-entries only: enter online at www.horse-events.co.uk **Closing date is Wed 21st May.**

Please enter as individual stating name of Branch/Centre. All team members also judged as individuals.

Qualifying Places Notes:

Only for the PC70 / PC80 and PC110 classes, if a qualifying individual is also in a qualifying team, the individual qualification place passes down to the next rider.

For PC90 and PC100 the team and individual Championship competitions are run separately, and on different days at the Champs. Combinations can qualify for both individual and team classes separately so for this reason there is no passing down of individual qualification if rider has a team qualification.

Combinations (Horse and Rider) can compete at TWO adjacent heights as follows:

PC70/PC70+ and PC80 **OR** PC80 and PC90 **OR** PC90 and PC100 **OR** PC100 and PC110.

There are some restrictions as to eligibility for each height. Please check latest PC SJ rule book.

1A <i>Classes 1A and 1B will run together</i>	70cm	<p>PC70 Regional Championships Qualifier Competition for Teams and Individuals.</p> <p>First round height: maximum of 0.70m. Second round: max. of 0.70m with two single fences at 0.75m Second rounds will be run as single phase (no jump off) .</p> <p>Riders must be aged 13 and under on 1st January 2025. Combination of Horse and Rider are NOT eligible if they have:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Previously achieved a double clear in any competition with a starting height of 90cm or above in the previous or current calendar year. - Previously ever finished 1st – 3rd as an individual in Show Jumping or Eventing at a PC70 Regional Championships on two occasions.
1B <i>Classes 1A and 1B will run together</i>	70cm	<p>PC70 PLUS Regional Championships Qualifier Competition for individuals only</p> <p>First round height: maximum of 0.70m. Second round: max. of 0.70m with two single fences at 0.75m Second rounds will be run as single phase (no jump off) .</p> <p>Riders must be aged 14 and over on 1st January 2025. Combination of Horse and Rider are NOT eligible if they have:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Previously achieved a double clear in any competition with a starting height of 90cm or above in the previous or current calendar year. - Previously ever finished 1st – 3rd as an individual in Show Jumping or Eventing at PC70 Regional Championships on two occasions.

2	80cm	<p>PC80 Regional Championships Qualifier for Teams & Individuals</p> <p>First round height: maximum of 0.80m. Second round: max. of 0.80m with two single fences at 0.85m. Second rounds will be run as single phase (no jump off) .</p> <p>Combination of Horse and Rider are NOT eligible if they have:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Previously achieved a double clear in any competition with a starting height of 100cm or above in the previous or current calendar year. - Previously ever finished 1st – 3rd as an individual in Show Jumping or Eventing at a PC80 Regional Championships on two occasions.
3	90cm	<p>PC90 Area Qualifier for Teams & Individuals</p> <p>First round: maximum height of 0.90m. Second round: maximum height of 0.95m Will have a separate jump off for those on equal faults in qualifying places.</p> <p>Combination of Horse and Rider are NOT eligible if they have:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Previously achieved a double clear in any competition with a starting height of 110cm or above in the previous or current calendar year. - Previously ever finished 1st – 3rd as an individual at the Pony Club Show Jumping/Eventing Championships at PC90 level or above on two occasions.
4	100cm	<p>PC 100 Area Qualifier for Teams & Individuals</p> <p>First round: maximum height of 1.00m. Second round: maximum height of 1.05m Will have a separate jump off for those on equal faults in qualifying places.</p> <p>Combination of Horse and Rider are NOT eligible if they have:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Previously achieved a double clear in any competition with a starting height of 120cm or above in the previous or current calendar year. - Previously ever finished 1st – 3rd as an individual at the Pony Club Championships at PC100 level or above on two occasions
5	110cm	<p>PC 110 Area Qualifier for Teams and Individuals</p> <p>First round: maximum height of 1.10m. Second round: maximum height of 1.15m</p> <p>Will run as two sections – Pony Section and Horse Section.</p> <p>Will have a separate jump off for those on equal faults in qualifying places.</p> <p>Open to all members and horses.</p>

Classes **3, 4** and **5** will be qualifiers for The JCB Pony Club Championships 2025 to be held at Offchurch Bury, Warwickshire 9th – 17th August 2025 (exact date for SJ to be confirmed)

Classes **1A and 1B** and **2** will be qualifiers for the 2025 Pony Club Regional Championships at Rectory Farm, Duntisbourne Abbots on 23rd – 25th August 2025.

Eligibility: Please check full eligibility criteria noted the Pony Club SJ Rulebook 2025.

Prizegiving: will be unmounted. Please wear correct turnout for the presentation.

Rosettes: Individuals to 10th place. Teams to 6th place.

Entry Fee: £30 per combination per class (to include first aid contribution) plus a non-refundable booking fee set by Horse-Events.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- PASSPORTS:** horses/ponies will not be allowed to compete without their passport with valid flu vaccinations – DCs/Centre Proprietors may be asked to confirm that your horse's/pony's flu vaccination record is correct and up to date. **Passports will be spot checked for compliance. A horse with a non-compliant passport will NOT be allowed to compete (nor will any horse/pony it has travelled to the venue with on the day) and there will be no refund of entry. Please allow time for passport checking and check the Pony Club website for current rules.**
- NUMBERS: rider numbers MUST be printed out by each competitor.** If wearing a number bib please wear front and back. If the number is to be put on the saddlecloth – please do A5 size and wear both sides. If the number is to be worn on the back of the rider, then please print at least A5 size. Numbers to be printed/written as large as possible in dark ink please. Competitor numbers MUST always be visible whilst mounted.
- TEAMS:** to be made up of 3 or 4 combinations: best three scores to count. See PC SJ Rule Book 2025 for further qualification details.
- TURN OUT:** Competitors must be turned out correctly with hair tied back securely and any body piercings ideally removed. If they must be worn, those visible must be studded and covered with tape or plaster so they are secure.
- HATS** must be tagged with a **Pink 2025** hat tag in order to compete.
- SPURS / PADDED BATONS:** All spurs worn anywhere on the showground, by any competitor, must comply with 2025 Pony Club Rules. Only those competitors with a **yellow (spurs) hat tag** are allowed to wear spurs. Only padded batons as specified in the PC Rules may be used anywhere on the showground.
- WELFARE:** Any abuse of horses/ponies, officials, other competitors, or members of the public will not be tolerated and those found doing so will be asked to leave the venue with no compensation and may be reported to the relevant authority. We are all volunteers working to provide your children with a successful day so please be KIND.
- CLOSING DATE** for entries is **Wed 21st May 2025**. Refunds for withdrawal will be given prior to the closing date. All refunds will be subject to £5 administration fee. Withdrawals after closing date will not be refunded.
- The Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry, alter order of classes, cancel classes, and/or limit entries.
- CHANGES / SUBSTITUTIONS:** If you would like to edit your horse or rider details before the closing date, please login to your Horse Events account and edit your booking under the 'MY BOOKING' Tab. If you would like to change the class, please email info@horse-events.co.uk and if there is space available, we will do this for you. Substitutions may be made in case of illness, lameness or other unavoidable circumstances and is certified by DC, their representative changes can be made as long as before the start of the class. For ALL changes of horse and rider substitutions after the closing date there is a £5 charge. - TIMES/DRAWN ORDERS** will be available after 6pm Wed 28th May. Please see Pony Club Results website. Competitors may be asked to jump up to 15 minutes before their given time – so please be ready!
- WARM-UP ARENA:** A maximum of 8 ponies / horses will be allowed in the warm-up arena at one time. Only stewards or one person per combination over the age of 16 may alter the jumps in the warm-up arena. Absolutely no small children, buggies, dogs allowed in the in the warm-up arena.
- Judges' decision is final.** Any objection must be handed to the Day Secretary in writing with a £50 deposit (which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld) within 15 minutes of the incident and BEFORE the end of that class.
- Stallions are allowed with prior permission from the Organiser; any stallion ridden by a Pony Club member must have written permission from their DC/Centre Proprietor which must be sent Kate Mather at NCHPC prior to the show day. Stallions must wear stallion discs and ribbons.
- All horse/ponies must be at least 5 years old on day of competition.
- INSURANCE:** please ensure that you have adequate/appropriate insurance for rider, horse, property & third party.
- PHOTOGRAPHS:** by entering this competition you are agreeing to be photographed whilst competing; these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not wish to be photographed please let the organisers know in advance of the competition.
- In the event of the competition being abandoned, for whatever reason, a refund of 50% of the entry fee will be made via horse-events. All refunds will be subject to an administration fee.
- Participants attend at their own risk; neither the Organisers or Moreton Showground will be liable for any loss, damage or accident to horses, riders, property, or other persons.
- No horses/ponies may be left tied to the outside of trailers/lorries without supervision. Please clear any muck/rubbish and do not leave on the field/lorry park. Please park cars as directed – not by the lorries.
- DOGS:** All dogs must be kept on a lead and under close control at all times and must be cleared up after.
- The show will be run under **The Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2025**. Rules available on the Pony Club website.
