Competition Rules and Conditions (Full rules can be found the in the Horsemanship rulebook 2024)

- 1. Branches must be from Area 9 and may enter teams for senior, junior and mini team. There is no limit to the number of teams a branch can enter.
- 2. **Senior teams -** To consist of three Members. Ages to be under 25 years on the 1st January 2024. One Member to be 16 years and under on the 1st January 2024. Of the remaining two Members, one may be between 21 and 24 on the 1st January 2024.
 - **Questions**: will be based on the Care section of the C+, B and AH Efficiency Test cards. *Questions at AH test level will be used sparingly.*
- 3. **Junior teams** To consist of three Members. Ages to be 13 years and under on the 1st January 2024, with one Member to be 11 years or under on the 1st January 2024 **Questions:** will be based on the Care section of the D and D+, C and easier parts of the C+ Efficiency Test cards and Horsemanship Achievements Badges.
- 4. Mini teams To consist of three Members. Ages to be 10 years and under on the 1st January 2024, with one Member to be 8 years or under on the 1st January 2024.
 Questions: will be based on the Care section of the E, D and easier parts of the D+ Efficiency Test cards and Mini Horsemanship Achievement badges.
- 5. Area Teams A Branch/Centre unable to raise a complete team may combine with other Branch/Centres within their Area. Members may only combine with the permissions of their District Commissioners/Centre Proprietors and the Area Horse & Pony Care Representative; fair and objective criteria must be applied when selecting these Members. Area teams are to enable smaller Branches/Centres to field teams of Members who otherwise would be unable to do so. An Area Team must comprise of three Members from two or more Branches/Centres e.g. three Branches/Centres with one individual each, two Branches/Centres with two and one individuals. Branches/ Centres should communicate with their Area Representative/Centre Coordinator to form Area Teams.
- 6. Members age must be as at 1st January 2024.
- 7. The decision of the organisers and judges is final.
- 8. Entries close on Monday 1st April, 2024

General Conditions

- 1. Bad language or behaviour by competitors or their supporters will not be tolerated and will result in the person being sent off site.
- 2. NO DOGS ALLOWED.
- 3. **Health, safety and welfare**: the organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all official and stewards.
- 4. **Legal liability**: Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or the Pony Club or any agent, employee or representative of these bodies nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to



competitors, spectators, their contents and accessories or any other personal property whatsoever caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

Recommended Dress Code

Pony Club Sweatshirt, Gilets or Jackets may be worn, Branch polo shirt may be worn in the event of warm weather, Membership Badge, Gloves, Jodhpurs/breeches. **Footwear** – Safe footwear for being around horses must be worn – this includes long boots and jodhpur boots and yard boots that are not suitable for riding may be worn. Plain black or brown half chaps may be worn with Jodhpur boots of the same colour. **Hats** – should be fitted with a **pink** Pony Club hat tag which indicates that the hat meets the accepted standard.
