Section 1: Dressage and Jumping – 1 class per combination for classes 1 -8

Class 1	6 yrs & under lead rein	Walk Trot test 2022	Jumps cross pole
Class 2	9 yrs & under (assisted)	Walk Trot test 2022	Jumps not over 45cm
Class 3	13 yrs and under	PC 70 Dressage 2022	Jumps not over 55cm
Class 4	13 yrs and under	PC 70 Dressage 2022	Jumps not over 70cm
Class 5	Grass roots	Grassroots Test PC80 2018	Jumps not over 80cm
Class 6	Novice	Novice Eventing PC90 2013	Jumps not over 90cm
Class 7	Inter	Int Eventing PC100 2015	Jumps not over 100cm
Class 8	Open	Open Eventing PC110 2022	Jumps not over 110cm

Section 2: Dressage Only

Class 9	Preliminary (under 13 years)	PC 70 test 2022
Class 10	Grassroots	Grassroots PC80 Championship Test 2024
Class 11	Novice	Novice Dressage 2020
Class 12	Intermediate	Intermediate Dressage 2024
Class 13	Open Area	PC Open Dressage Test 2020

Classes 4-13 are the Area Team tests and heights.

Classes will not run in class order. We have 1 or 2 dressage arenas and 1 SJ arena.

Section 3: Show Jumping only - These will run in-between the classes above

Class 14 Lead Rein	Jumps very small (rider may not enter class 15 and above)
Class 15 assistance permitted	50cm
Class 16	60cm
Class 17	75cm
Class 18	85cm
Class 19	95cm
Class 20	105cm
Class 21	110/115cm

All classes will run– If clear, Jump off straight away over shortened course, timed.

RULES

- * If a competitor starts on the Lead rein they must stay on the lead rein all day. Class 1 and 14 are the only lead rein. LR riders may enter class 15 but must be off LR but can be assisted.
- * Classes 1- 9 – one entry per combination.
- * * All classes run under Pony Club Dressage and Show Jumping Rules 2024.
- * Class 1 to 5 and class 9 + 10 can use any normal riding bit in the dressage.
- * Only classes 1 to 5 and 9+10 may have a commander for the dressage. All others must be ridden from memory (run under Area competition rules)
- * Hats must be worn at all times. PC Members must abide by PC hat rule (11) and hats need to be tagged.
- * All dressage tests are available on the pony club web site www.pcuk.org
- * Trophy to winning combination (or highest placed CFHS member) in each of the classes 1-13.
- * Ponies/horses must be tacked up properly and riders appropriately dressed for all classes at all times.
- * **PLEASE MAKE SURE ON THE DAY YOU PRESENT TO THE DRESSAGE ARENA 10MINS BEFORE YOUR TIME OR YOU WILL BE ELIMINATED**
- * Medial cover at our events complies with PC rules
- * We reserve the right to refuse entries from those we feel are over qualified/or entered the wrong class.
- * Maximum height of jumps in practice ring will be no higher than the class being jumped.
- * **ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT FULL PAYMENT** booked via horse events

*** At all our events objections must be accompanied by a deposit of £10 that will be refunded if the objection is upheld within 30 mins of the class finishing. Results will be posted for 30mins before any prizegiving.**
