



SCOTTISH HUNTER TRIALS CHAMPIONSHIPS QUALIFIER-SUNDAY 25TH MAY 2025 from 10AM
LANARKSHIRE & RENFREWSHIRE PONY CLUB & HUNT
At Lawfield Trout Fishery, Kilallan Road, Kilmacolm, PA13 4PA
(Follow signs for Lawfield Trout Fishery)

CLASS 1 – 45CM NURSERY NOVICE—ponies and horses will be judged separately.
(Combination never to have won first in any XC competition – Genuine Nursery Novice only please)

CLASS 2 – PAIRS FOR NURSERY NOVICE COURSE- ponies and horses will not be judged separately. If already completed Class 1, ponies and horses must be fit enough to then do this Class.

CLASS 3 – 70/75 CM NOVICE -ponies and horses will be judged separately. This is a qualifier for the 80cm class at The Scottish Hunter Trials Championships at Foresterseat on 21st September 2025.

CLASS 4 – 90/95CM INTERMEDIATE -ponies and horses will be judged separately. This is a qualifier for the 90cm class at The Scottish Hunter Trials Championships at Foresterseat on 21st September 2025.

CLASS 5-PAIRS FOR NOVICE/INTERMEDIATE COURSE- pairs can jump either height. Ponies and horses will not be judged separately. If already completed Classes 3 or 4, ponies and horses must be fit enough to then do this Class. There will be certain fences which must be jumped at the same time or a time penalty of 10 seconds will be added.

Enter online at www.horse-events.co.uk. All entries are subject to a non-refundable booking fee which will be stated online on a per class basis. Start times will be posted on facebook by 5pm on Friday 23rd May. Entries close at 5pm on Thursday 22nd May.

COST OF CLASS 1 - £25 for PC members and Hunt subscribers and £30 for others.

COST OF CLASSES 3 & 4 - £35 for PC members and Hunt subscribers and £40 for others.

COST OF CLASSES 2 & 5 -£40 PER PAIR -ALL CLASSES INCLUDE 1ST AID COVER

XC BIBS MUST BE WORN AND RIDERS MUST BRING OWN NUMBERS. A £10 DEPOSIT IS REQUIRED FOR BIBS AND WILL BE REFUNDED WHEN THE BIB IS RETURNED. OWN BIBS CAN BE WORN. ONLY 1 CLASS AND A PAIRS CLASS PER COMBINATION.

Rosettes 1st – 6th place. Classes will be split into horses/ponies if numbers are sufficient and Classes will be judged to an optimum time.

Course may be walked from 4pm on Saturday 24th May.

ACCESS TO THE SITE WILL BE SIGNPOSTED AND IS VIA A ONE WAY ROAD SYSTEM FROM HOUSTON VILLAGE ALONG KILALLAN ROAD AND THEN EXITING THE SITE BY TURNING RIGHT ALONG HOUSTON ROAD AND THROUGH KILMACOLM. PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOU FOLLOW THIS ONE WAY SYSTEM. PLEASE ALSO NOTE THAT NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED ON THE SITE AT ANY TIME EITHER IN CARS/LORRIES OR ON THE COURSE. THIS ALSO INCLUDES THE COURSE WALK.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The event will be run generally under Pony Club Eventing Rules 2025 amended where appropriate to suit this form of competition. Pony Club Eventing rules can be downloaded from the Pony Club website <http://www.pcuk/index.php/disciplines/eventing/eveningrules>

In the event of cancellation £5.00 per entry may be retained to cover expenses.

Withdrawals after the closing date will forfeit the entry fee unless supported by a medical/vet certificate.

IN THE EVENT OF BAD WEATHER, THE ORGANISERS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO ABANDON/CANCEL THE EVENT. A DECISION WILL BE MADE BY 9PM ON SATURDAY 24TH MAY.

Competitors must wear current approved safety headgear and body protector. Long hair must be secured in such a way to ensure riders numbers are visible at all times. **IF THIS IS NOT ADHERED TO YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE.**

PC Members must comply with Tack and Dress Code in the Pony Club Eventing Rule Book 2025.

Non-Pony Club competitors must ensure their tack and clothing is safe and appropriate for the competition, must have their own appropriate Public Liability Insurance cover and may be asked to provide proof of cover.

All competitors must attend the secretary's tent to register prior to competing. Hats will be tagged and body protectors checked to ensure tack and other equipment is safe and appropriate for the competition and complies with current safety standards. It is the responsibility of the competitor to wear a medical armband if they have a medical condition.

No earrings/jewellery may be worn while competing.

Competitors failing to complete the course must report back to the starter. Any competitor wearing a body cage must lodge a key with the Course Starter and will be responsible for collecting on completion of their round.

Competitors who have a fall at any point on the course will not be allowed to continue and must walk back on foot and report to the paramedics. It will be at the paramedics' discretion as to



whether the competitor can take further part in the competition. Competitors who have 3 refusals at the one jump will not be allowed to continue.

Electric devices (i.e. headphones, mobile phones etc enabling another person to communicate with the rider) are not allowed whilst the rider is competing. No recording device is permitted – i.e. head/bridle cameras etc. With the exception of Classes 1 and 2, stop watches and other timing devices are allowed.

Neither Lanarkshire & Renfrewshire Branch of the Pony Club, Lanarkshire & Renfrewshire Hunt, The Pony Club, or any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accept any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.

The organisers of this event have taken responsible precautions to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all responsible precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the Organiser, Officers, Stewards and Judges.
