Class Information

ODC (Classes 3, 5, 8 & 10) - These classes will run similar to a **Mini One Day Event** starting with dressage followed by the show jumping approx. 30 mins. after completing your dressage test. You will receive **start times** for both your dressage and show jumping phase <u>only</u> as the working hunter jumping will follow directly on from the show jumping.

Penalties - Timed on optimum time (325/min or 350/min depending on class)

5 penalties for a knock down, 5 penalties for a refusal

3 refusals = elimination, rider or horse fall = elimination

Other Information

- A valid passport and vaccination record must accompany the horse/pony to all events and be available for inspection. Horse must be vaccinated in accordance with BRC rules: www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-club/news
- None of the working hunter jumps will be fixed.
- Penalties will be the same for both the show jumping and the working hunter jumping phases: 5 for a knockdown, 5 for 1st refusal, 10 for 2nd refusal and elimination for 3rd refusal. Fall of horse, rider or both will result in elimination and you must leave the ring dismounted.
- The jumping phase will be timed and in the event of an overall tie on penalties the rider nearest the optimum time will win.
- No Stopwatches allowed, the optimum time will be available on the day.
- If you are eliminated for 3 refusals you may have chance to jump a few more fences but as all the riders have a set time to start their show jumping phase you may not get to complete the full course.
- The courses can be walked from 8:30 a.m. on the Sunday morning or at predetermined intervals between classes – please ask the stewards permission before walking into any of the rings. The courses won't change for any of the classes; the jumps will just increase in height.
- Horses and ponies must be 4 years or over
- Back protectors are **required**.
- Show Jackets or cross-country attire can be worn for the jumping phases but show jackets must be worn for the dressage.
- Hats must be worn with harnesses properly adjusted and fastened: They MUST adhere to <u>BRC standards</u>.
- Skull cap hats must be worn with a silk.
- Please ensure you have adequate insurance cover for your horse/pony
