Rules

- The show committee reserves the right to modify the schedule/classes as necessary and may refuse entry.
- Classes may clash and it is the competitors' responsibility to inform the ring steward if they withdraw from a class or will be late.
- The Judges' decision is final. Any objection should be made in writing to the Secretary on the day within an hour of the class concerned with a £10 deposit which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- No Galloping outside the rings.
- All competitors take part at their own risk and should be mindful of their own and others' safety at all times.
- The organisers or landowners accept no responsibility for accidents, loss or damage to animals, competitors, spectators or property.
- The practice jump will be flagged (red flag on right) and an adult must be in attendance when in use.
- All Jumping classes will be SINGLE PHASE, the second half will be timed. All competitors may jump the second half unless they have been eliminated
- Classes will take place in the order presented on the schedule and timings will depend on the number of competitors entering on the day. As such, no times will be released in advanced (including for the qualifying classes), please ensure you arrive in good time and report to the ring steward.
- Dogs to preferably stay at home. Those that must be brought to the event must be kept on a lead at all times.
- All persons mounted must wear a protective riding helmet which conforms to current Pony Club 2025 hat tagging rules.
- The wearing of body protectors is recommended
- Horses and ponies ridden must be at least 4 years of age.
- Competitors' ages as at 1st January 2025
- Whips and spurs are NOT allowed in gymkhana events
- Please be respectful of our kind landowners, please clean up after your pony/horse and do not muck out your trailers or leave any rubbish behind
- Anyone demonstrating offensive behaviour or maltreating animals at the show will be asked to leave immediately

- 17. **Best Coloured Horse or Pony**, open to skewbald, piebald, dun, palomino and spotted ponies, may be led Sash to the winner, rosettes and best Tiverton member
- 18. **Best Veteran Horse or Pony**, aged 15 years and over, any height, may be led Sash to the winner, rosettes and best Tiverton member
- 19. **Lead Rein Pony 12.2hh and under**, must be led Sash to winner, rosettes and Best Tiverton Member
- 20. **Best First Pony 13.2hh and under**, may be led Sash to the winner, rosettes and Best Tiverton Member

CHAMPIONSHIP FOR ALL 1^{ST} AND 2^{ND} PLACE WINNERS (15-20) - SASHES TO CHAMPION AND RESERVE Not before 1pm (lunch break if time)

- 21. **Best Rider**, split into sections **a. 10yrs and under** and **b. 11yrs and over**, may be led Sash to winner, rosettes and Best Tiverton Member
 - 22. **Best Combination of Horse and Rider,** split into sections **a. 10yrs and under** and **b. 11yrs and over**, may be led Sash to winner, rosettes and best Tiverton member
 - 23. **Best Hunting Type** (Horse or Pony), will be required to jump a small jump (may be led) Sash to winner, rosettes and best Tiverton member.
 - 24. **Pony Club/Riding Club Type**, will be required to jump a small fence, any height or age (may be led) Sash to winner, rosettes and Best Tiverton Member.
 - 25. **Best Family Pony** (may be led), any height or age Sash to winner, rosettes and best Tiverton member
 - 26. **Child's Best Friend**, may be led, 11 years and younger Sash to the winner, rosettes and Best Tiverton Member
