CLASS 1: PC80 TEAM AND INDIVIDUAL

Kindly sponsored by Hamptons

This is a two-round competition.

Fences in 1st round 80cm; 2nd round 80cm with two single fences at 85cm which will be run as a Single Phase and in the case of a tie after 2 rounds the time taken in the second phase of the second round will be used to decide the results and there will not be a jump off.

No combination entered in Class 1 can compete in Class 3, 4 or 5.

The top 6 teams will qualify for the Regional Championships on 30 & 31 August at Aston Le Walls, as well as the top 16 individuals WHO HAVE NOT QUALIFIED AS PART OF A TEAM.

CLASS 2: PC70 TEAM AND INDIVIDUAL JUMPING AND PC70 PLUS (INDIVIDUAL ONLY)

Section A- Riders 13 and under Kindly sponsored by HG IFA Ltd

Section B- (70 PLUS) – Riders 14 and over

Kindly sponsored by Charlotte Fountain - Master Saddle Fitter

This is a two-round competition.

Fences in 1st round 70cm; 2nd round 70cm with two single fences at 75cm which will be run as a Single Phase and in the case of a tie after 2 rounds the time taken in the second phase of the second round will be used to decide the results and there will not be a jump off.

No combination entered in Class 2 can compete in Class 3, 4 or 5.

PC70 - The top 6 teams will qualify for the Regional Championships on 30 & 31 August at Aston Le Walls, as well as the top 16 individuals WHO HAVE NOT QUALIFIED AS PART OF A TEAM.

PC70 PLUS - the first 5 placed individuals will qualify

Note teams must comprise riders in section A

Rosettes will be awarded to teams and section A individuals in $1^{st} - 6^{th}$ place and section B individuals in $1^{st} - 6^{th}$ place.

 N.B. Classes 1 and 2 If a Team is eliminated in the first round any member not eliminated will be allowed to jump in the second round. If a team member is eliminated in the first round he/she may jump again in the second round, provided the Team has not been eliminated, and is eligible to count

CLASS 3: 40cm TEAM AND INDIVIDUAL JUMPING

Kindly sponsored by JRG Pet Equestrian

Rides in class 3 only may be led or assisted. Class will be split between assisted & unassisted if class entries permit.

Single phase; height of fences will be approximately 40cm.

Special rosettes will be awarded to all competitors jumping a clear round.

No rider competing in Class 3 can ride in Class 1 or 2.

CLASS 4: 50cm TEAM AND INDIVIDUAL JUMPING Kindly sponsored by ELLIOTT OF LONDON

Single phase; height of fences will be approximately 50cm.

No rider competing in Class 4 can ride in Class 1 or 2.

CLASS 5: 60cm TEAM AND INDIVIDUAL JUMPING Kindly sponsored by Orchid Property Group

Single phase; height of fences will be approximately 60cm.

No rider competing in Class 5 can ride in Class 1 or 2.

CLASS 6: PC 90 - Team and Individual

Two-round competition, team total of the best three scores to count in each round. That total is carried forward to the second round.

Maximum height 2nd round 95cm.

Qualifying places and placings to be decided on time in the timed section of the 2nd round.

CLASS 7: PC100 - Team and Individual

Kindly sponsored by Arnold Thompson

Two-round competition, team total of the best three scores to count in each round. That total is carried forward to the second round.

Maximum height 2nd round 1.05m.

Qualifying places and placings to be decided on time in the timed section of the 2nd round.

CLASS 8: PC110 – Team and Individual

Class to be jumped over 2 rounds.

Maximum height 2nd round 1.15m

In the event of a tie for qualifying places, there will be a jump-off.

- N.B. Class 6-8 If a Team is eliminated in the first round any member not eliminated will be allowed to jump
 in the second round. If a team member is eliminated in the first round he/she may jump again in the second
 round, provided the Team has not been eliminated, and is eligible to count
- Classes 6-8 are open to Pony Club Branches in Area 12
- Top 2 teams* and top 5 individuals will qualify for the JCB Pony Club Championships at Offchurch Bury in August 2025. (*depending on entry numbers, see rulebook)
- No horse/rider competing in class 6-8 may compete in classes 3-5.
- Classes 6-8 changes to be made via Grafton Entrymaster. Any changes after times are published, or queries about classes 6-8 to be made to Carolyn Harvey grafton@pcuk.org
- Late entries/substitutions after the closing date will be subject to a £5 late entry charge

PRIZEGIVING

Prizegivings will take place at the end of each class unmounted by the secretary's area. Competitors must be correctly attired.

Rosettes will be awarded to individuals in 1st - 8th place and Teams in 1st - 6th place

ENTRIES

All entries should be made online as above, and will be subject to a non-refundable booking fee. This is a single booking form and entries will not be confirmed without payment. For entries you will need your Membership Number and Branch/Centre.

All qualifier class (Class 1, 2, 6, 7, 8) entries are for Area 12 members only, and must be approved by your Branch DC or Centre Proprietor.

Classes 3, 4 & 5 are open to all PC members.

Note: In all classes individual entries will be added together to create mixed Teams wherever possible.

All teams will comprise of 4 members, with the top 3 scores to count in each round.

For all classes, once entries close, a list of entries from each Branch/Centre will be sent to DCs/Proprietors for the allocation of Team Places.

If you need to edit your Horse/Rider details before the Closing Date, please login to your relevant online account and edit your booking.

After the closing date, all substitutions may be made only in accordance with The Pony Club Showjumping Rules 2025.

WITHDRAWALS AND REFUNDS

Withdrawals prior to the closing date for entries, a full refund less the administration charge will be given

Withdrawals after the closing date will NOT be refunded except on the production of a valid Doctor's or Vet's certificate.

In the event of abandonment, entry fees will be refunded less booking fees and any administration charge.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. A horse/rider combination may enter 2 consecutive height classes. Classes 1-2, 6, 7, 8 are two-round competition with possible jump-offs, so please take your horse or pony's welfare and fitness into consideration when making your entry decisions.
- 2. All classes are run under the guidance of the Pony Club Show Jumping 2025 Rules.
- 3. The decision of the Judge and Steward is final.
- 4. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- 5. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at the Event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
- There is to be no outside assistance (except for Class 3 40cm), leading around jumps or lunging.
- 7. Any fall will automatically count as elimination, competitors to leave the Ring unmounted.
- 8. The use of foul language or misuse of spurs will not be tolerated and will lead to immediate elimination.

- A valid passport and vaccination record must accompany the horse/pony to this event and must be available
 for inspection if required by event officials. Vaccinations must be in accordance with the current Pony Club
 vaccination rules 2024. https://pcuk.org/media/the-pony-club-equine-influenza-vaccinationrule-2024-v7.pdf
- 10. Any requests for Reasonable Adjustment must be made by the closing date to vahsecretary@gmail.com or grafton@pcuk.org https://pcuk.org/officials/equality-diversity/reasonable-adjustment
- 11. All competitors must download and print their numbers from www.ponyclubresults.co.uk. These will be available when times are published. Numbers must be displayed front and back in a number bib and must be worn at all times when mounted. Competitors must bring their own number bib. 1 copy of the number is to be displayed in the front of vehicle on entry to Showground.
- 12. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure their dress and tack complies with current pony club regulations. All hats must be tagged with current tag. Any competitor found to be in breach of these regulations may be disqualified at any time during or after the competition.
- 13. **Photographic Rights** competitors and their parents/guardians have given permission for any photographic and/or film or TV footage taken of persons or horses/ponies taking part in Pony Club events to be used and published in any media whatsoever for editorial purposes, press information or advertising by or on behalf of the Pony Club and/or Official Sponsors of the Pony Club.
- 14. On the day only DCs/Centre Proprietors or their appointed representatives are entitled to **lodge a protest or objection**. Protests/objections will be managed as per The Pony Club Show Jumping Rule Book 2025.
- 15. Entry to this competition constitutes acceptance of the Rules and Conditions.
