- The show committee reserves the right to modify the schedule/classes as necessary and may refuse entry.
- Classes may clash and it is the competitors' responsibility to inform the ring steward if they withdraw from a class or will be late.
- The Judges' decision is final. Any objection should be made in writing to the Secretary on the day within an hour of the class concerned with a £10 deposit which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- No Galloping outside the rings.
- All competitors take part at their own risk and should be mindful of their own and others' safety at all times.
- The organisers or landowners accept no responsibility for accidents, loss or damage to animals, competitors, spectators or property.
- The practice jump will be flagged (red flag on right) and an adult must be in attendance when in use.
- All Jumping classes will be SINGLE PHASE, the second half will be timed. All competitors may jump the second half unless they have been eliminated
- Classes will take place in the order presented on the schedule and timings will depend on the number of competitors entering on the day. As such, no times will be released in advanced (including for the qualifying classes), please ensure you arrive in good time and report to the ring steward.
- Dogs to preferably stay at home. Those that must be brought to the event must be kept on a lead at all times.
- All persons mounted must wear a protective riding helmet which conforms to current Pony Club 2024 hat tagging rules.
- The wearing of body protectors is recommended
- Horses and ponies ridden must be at least 4 years of age.
- Competitors' ages as at 1st January 2024
- Whips and spurs are NOT allowed in gymkhana events
- Please be respectful of our kind landowners, please clean up after your pony/horse and do not muck out your trailers or leave any rubbish behind
- Anyone demonstrating offensive behaviour or maltreating animals at the show will be asked to leave immediately
