RULES & TERMS OF ENTRY

- 1 Neither the landowner, organisers nor any person acting on their behalf can accept liability for any loss, damage accident, injury, illness to ponies, horses, competitors, owners, spectators or any other person or property.
- 2 The organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards. It is advised that all competitors should have their own third party liability cover.
- 3 By making an entry in any class a competitor agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of the Tedworth Show.
- 4 The organisers reserve the right to alter the events if necessary, to refuse entry or restrict the number of entries per class. In the event of small class entries the lower rosettes or prizes may be withheld.
- 5 All competitors are requested to make a £2 donation towards attending Paramedic costs.
- 6 There will be no refund of entry fees without a vet or doctor's certificate. Entry fees refunded will be subject to a £1.50 administration fee. Any dishonoured cheques will have an additional levy of £10 added to cover the cost of administration and bank charges.
- 7 Rider Age as at 1st January 2024.
- 8 All ridden horses/ponies must be four years and over.
- 9 Competitors must wear appropriate clothing for each class. Suitable footwear and Hard Hats conforming to current approved safety standards must be worn at all times (including the Fancy Dress class). It is advised that a back protector is worn for all jumping classes.
- 10 All classes will be judged in accordance with Pony Club rules and regulations.
- 11 The organisers have made every effort to avoid similar classes clashing. If your classes do clash then please speak to the stewards on the day and who will try to be accommodating. However please be aware that it is up to the judge to allow competitors to join classes late or leave early and it is your responsibility to ensure you are on time for your classes. No entry fees will be refunded if competitors miss their class.
- 12 We work on the premise that the judge's decision is final. Any objection is to be made to the secretary within 30 minutes of the event, together with £10.00, refundable at the discretion of the Committee.
- 13 Offensive behaviour by competitors or spectators will result in offenders being asked to leave the showground. This includes misuse of whips or bad language and rudeness to show officials and organisers.
- 14 Do not leave ponies/horses tied up unattended to the side of horseboxes/trailers.
- 15 No mucking out of horse boxes or trailers onto the field.
- 16 Please keep all dogs on short leads.
- 17 Please do not leave any litter behind.
- 18 All Tedworth members competing are expected to either help or provide someone to help in the setting up, clearing up or running of the show as a condition of entry. Please indicate when you/someone on your behalf would be available and we can then contact you directly with details.
- 19 Entries may be accepted on the day if competitors have already entered other classes and numbers permit this will be at the organiser's discretion.

Classes will be jumped as a single phase competition. Once the rider has completed the first course of fences, if they get a clear round, they will jump off immediately, with their time starting as they ride through the start.

PAIRS RELAY COMPETITION RULES:

Rider 1 does the round and after crossing the finish line they hand over the whip to the second rider who then does their round. Fastest clear round by both riders wins.

Competitors may only enter jumping classes in either Ring 1 or Ring 2

- 9 UNASSISTED Jumps approx. 30cm Sponsor: Maizy & Jackie
- 10 HORSE AND HOUND Jumps approx. 30cm Riders to jump a course of jumps mounted then dismount and jump the course on foot with dog on lead. Sponsor: E P Imelov Sport Horses
- 11 LED or ASSISTED Jumps approx. 40cm Sponsor: Wessex Equine Veterinary Practice
- 12 UNASSISTED Jumps approx. 40cm Sponsor: Summerdown Shoot
- 13 Jumps approx. 50cm Sponsor: AB Equine Transport

Classes will be jumped as a single phase competition. Once the rider has completed the first course of fences, if they get a clear round, they will jump off immediately, with their time starting as they ride through the start.

Competitors may only enter jumping classes in either Ring 1 or Ring 2

PLEASE NOTE

The 'spirit' of Ring 2 is that it is a confidence giver or an opportunity to school your horse in a show environment. Whilst Pony Club Rules will be observed these rings are aimed to give encouragement and support to young riders and their ponies. We would not condone ponies or horses being jumped round endlessly. If the Ring Steward feels that your horse or pony is tired or has done enough rounds they will be entitled to refuse you entry.

Clear Round Show Jumping (9.30 am - 2.00 pm)

The 'spirit' of Clear Round is to be used as a confidence giver or an opportunity to school your horse in a show environment. Whilst Pony Club Rules will be observed rounds will be limited to 2 per horse and if the Ring Steward feels your horse/pony has done enough they will be entitled to refuse your entry. **Entry Fees £5 for 2 rounds**
